A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE APPLICATION AND EXECUTION OF VIOLENT CRIME INTERVENTION FUND GRANTS FOR THE MCMINN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, in order to properly perform the duties of county government as prescribed by law, it is often in McMinn County's interest to enter contracts with other entities; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Criminal Justice Programs has issued a "Formula Based Grant" which allocates \$138,047.00 to McMinn County Sheriff's Department. These funds are intended to be used for a License Plate Reader system as well as some additional technology; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Criminal Justice Programs has issued a "Competitive Collaborative Grant" up to \$2,000,000.00. McMinn County Sheriff's Dept would partner with Polk County Sheriff's Department to hire four new Violent Crime/Sex Crime Detectives with dual county jurisdiction as well as four outfitted vehicles, a Cellbrite Phone Forensics system with training and other investigative supplies; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Joe Guy requests approval for application and execution of the OCJP Violent Crime Intervention Grants.
